II. Approval of Minutes
September 12, 2023

The minutes were approved unanimously and without objection.

III. Fall Updates

Dr. Stacey Patterson, Vice President for Research

Dr. Patterson presented the current research numbers and talked about the growth of research at FSU over the past ten years. Dr. Patterson also discussed the ongoing ASPIRE initiative and the current strategic recruitments. The FSU InSPIRE Institute is coming along, and recruitment is underway. She informed the Trustees that an NSF Engine proposal was submitted in August and FSU was selected to compete for \$160M, with the full proposal being due in February 2025. They are calling this proposal FLAME (Florida Advanced Manufacturing Engine). Dr. Patterson talked about the IGNITE FSU \$6M NSF award as well as giving updates on FSU Health.

Dr. Patton Terry gave an impressive overview of the scope and breadth of the FCRR and their role in student reading outcomes in our state, nationally, and internationally.
